Lomnice region – region of unexpected possibilities

Attractive region lying on the border of Bohemian Paradise and the Giant Mountains, which boasts far-reaching views, attractive natural and tourist destinations, with lots of cycling routes and ideal ski slopes.








The highest peak of Lomnice region is the hill Tábor (678 m above sea level) with Tichánek lookout tower, which is undoubtedly one of the dominant of Ještědsko – Kozákovský ridge.

Lomnice region also attracts international attention thanks to its integration into the European Geopark, Bohemian Paradise, UNESCO World Heritage site. Under the Tábor hill in a wide valley of the Popelka river, at an altitude of 478 m above sea level, is situated the town of Lomnice nad Popelkou with less than six thousand inhabitants.

The earliest mention can be found in Dalimil's chronicle from 1232. At the beginning of the 19th century started here the traditional production of famous Lomnice biscuits and wafers. Currently the city offers its visitors rich cultural and sports activities (Tyl theatre, cinema, chateau, city library, city museum and gallery, puppet theatre, sports hall, winter stadium, summer stadium, climbing wall, ski resort V Popelkách with open-air observation gallery on K-70 jumping bridge, sports airport, swimming pool).






